The Chamber relies mainly on its membership dues to sustain the ongoing expenses of maintaining the Chamber Office and website. This year's dues have been revamped to make Chamber membership more affordable for single person and family businesses. Individuals, not associated with a business, can join Chamber for a nominal fee of \$15.

Below is a description of the projects and events that are in place or proposed for 2012. All need volunteers.

- **Mineral County Business Directory:** contact county businesses to renew or place ads, collect ad money
- **Golf Tournament:** obtain sponsors, prizes, organize, & advertise annual golf tournament at Trestle Creek Golf Course in St. Regis
- **River Trail Project:** work at securing funding, facilitating the purchase of land, & developing a walking trail from Chamber office, 102 River St. in Superior, down to the Clark Fork River
- **Fly-In:** promote the Mineral County Airport by helping to organize & advertise a Fly-In, Summer 2012
- **Winterfest/Holiday Stroll:** secure participating businesses and organize activities to kick off the Christmas season in downtown Superior (ideally in Alberton & St. Regis, as well)
- **Chamber Office:** volunteer &/or obtain and organize volunteers to staff the Chamber office
- **County Clean-Up Project:** newly proposed project to clean up the county and possibly sell the scrap metal
