

## SUPERIOR (MT) **FAIR BUILDING** NEEDS COUNTY HELP !



The Mineral County Fair Board is asking for repair assistance from the Mineral County commissioners. Their concern is the **deterioration of the Fair building.** The Board Co-Chair reports that that the “building has been leaking for the past two to three years. The walls are buckling out and the ceiling

is sagging. **We are in jeopardy of losing our fair and building** for lack of funds and interest. The building needs the roof replaced as well the sides sealed.”

Ms. Janet Neville reports that the Fair Building is used daily by the 4-H shooting sports and most community functions since Superior does not have a community center. She reports that she’s been asking for county help for more than a year. Now, she writes, **“I am asking you to lend your support in writing letters and visiting with the commissioners to repair the existing building or replace it.”**

She says, “The estimated cost for repair would be between \$40,000 and \$65,000. I have taken them cost estimates and new building estimates as well.”
